







What is Burmese Teak?




- Burmese teak (tectona grandis), i.e., the best teak on earth, grows naturally in Myanmar (Burma)
- Myanmar's forests provide optimal growing conditions
- Prized for its durable and water-resistant qualities by marine industry for yacht decking
















Current Situation in Myanmar



Burmese teak sales supports the military

- February 2021 coup –
 Junta seizes all
 government institutions,
 including Myanmar
 Timber Enterprise (MTE)
- Military controls
 Myanmar's timber industry
 through MTE
- All revenue generated by MTE via teak sales funds the military



MTE Monthly Auctions

Military profiteering from monthly teak auctions

- 4000 teak logs to be auctioned between 2025-2026
- MTE accepting USD, EUR, CYN, THB
- Anyone using USD payments to buy teak from MTE breaches US sanctions

EU & US Laws Regulating Burmese Teak



EU Sanctions – MTE sanctioned June 21, 2021

- Cannot fund MTE directly or indirectly
- Cannot import teak that was in the possession of MTE after 21 June 2021

US Sanctions – MTE sanctioned April 21, 2021

- Cannot fund MTE directly or indirectly
- Cannot import teak that was in the possession of MTE after 21 April 2021
- Any US dollar payments to MTE by any individual or company, not just US, are prohibited by US sanctions law

EU Timber Regulation (EUTR) (Regulation (EU) No 995/2010) & **EU Deforestation Regulation** (EUDR) (Regulation (EU) 2023/1115)

- 2020 Conclusions of EUTR Experts Group determined impossible to determine negligible risk of illegally harvested timber from Myanmar
- EUTR to be repealed on 30 December 2024 by EU Deforestation Regulation


Lacey Act (Amended 2008)

- Prohibits the import of timber and wood products into the US that have been harvested, transported or sold in violation of foreign or US state laws
- Violation includes theft & taking of plants from park, forest reserves, protected areas
- Violation includes failure to pay royalties, taxes or fees

US Imports since April 21, 2021, Sanctions




US (HS code 4407) Imports from Myanmar

Recent Court Cases



- Oceanco fined €150,000 by Openbaar Ministerie for teak on Jeff Bezos' yacht Koru
- Sunseeker International criminally convicted and fined over £350,000 for breach of UK Timber Regulation
- CJEU ruling on WOB Timber and previous EU sanctions regime



Summary



Burmese teak trade continues to cause deforestation and support Myanmar military

- Despite laws regulating timber in EU & US, large quantities of teak entering markets
- Implementation of financial sanctions still have not stopped the trade in blood timber
- Traders obfuscating Myanmar origin to avoid detection and enforcement actions
